- Session 9: Non-Parametric Tests 1: Chi-Square tests
- Session 10: Non-Parametric Tests 2: Mann-Whitney U test and Wilcoxon signed-rank test
- Session 11: Non-Parametric Tests 2: Kruskal- Wallis H test and Friedman test
- Session 12: Correlation and Applied Regression Analysis
