1. Common Assembly and Attendance

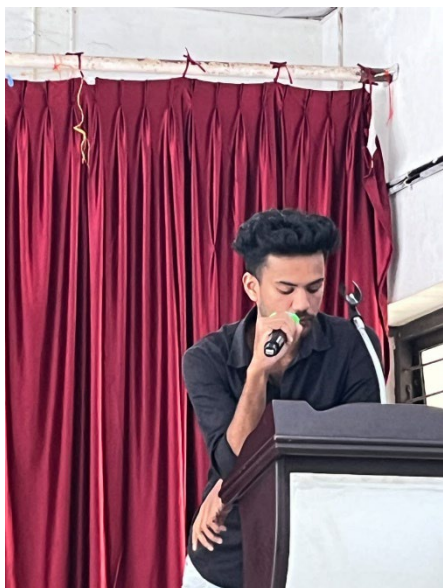
The event commenced with a common assembly where attendance was taken. This initial gathering set the tone for unity and respect among students and faculty.
