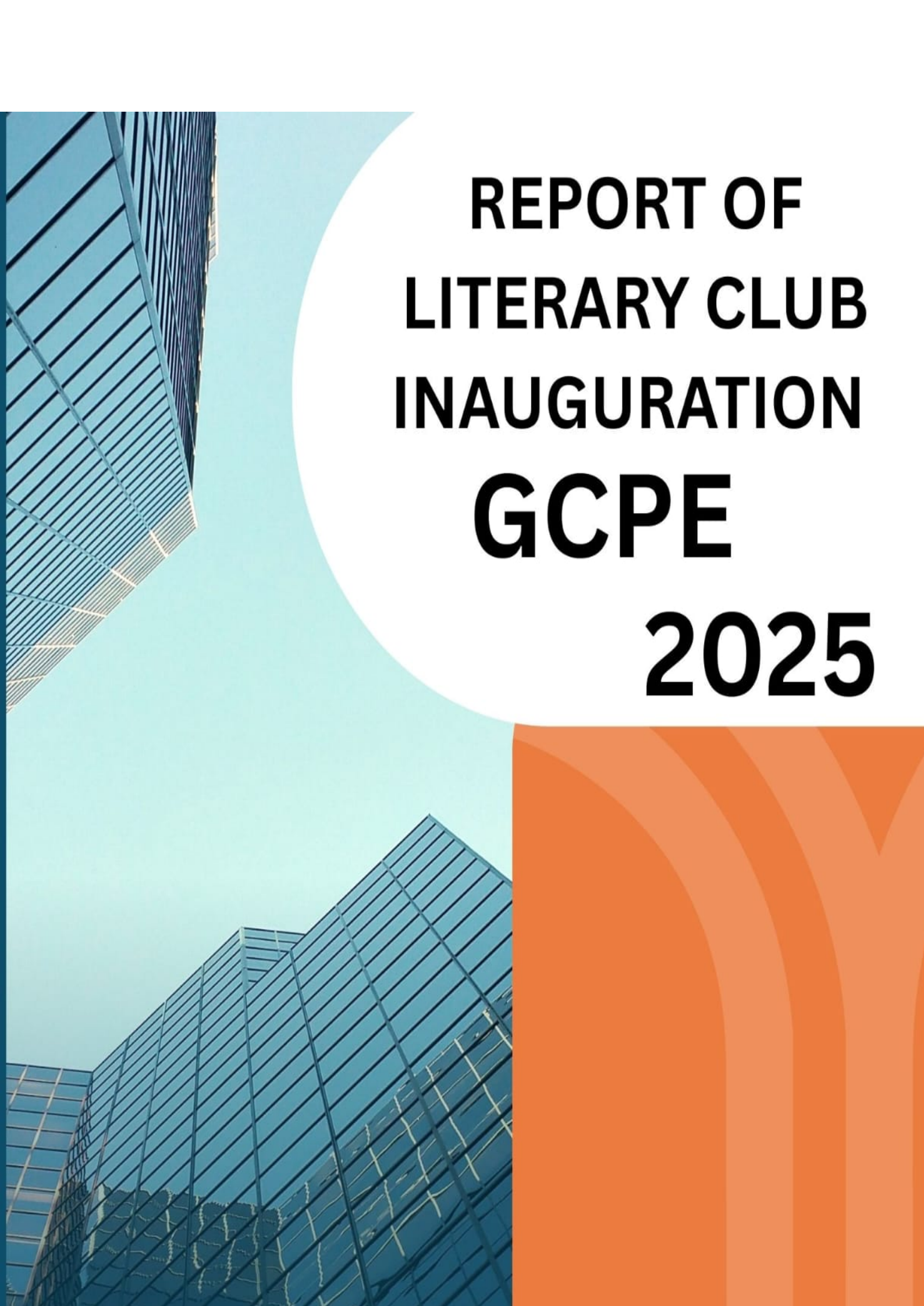

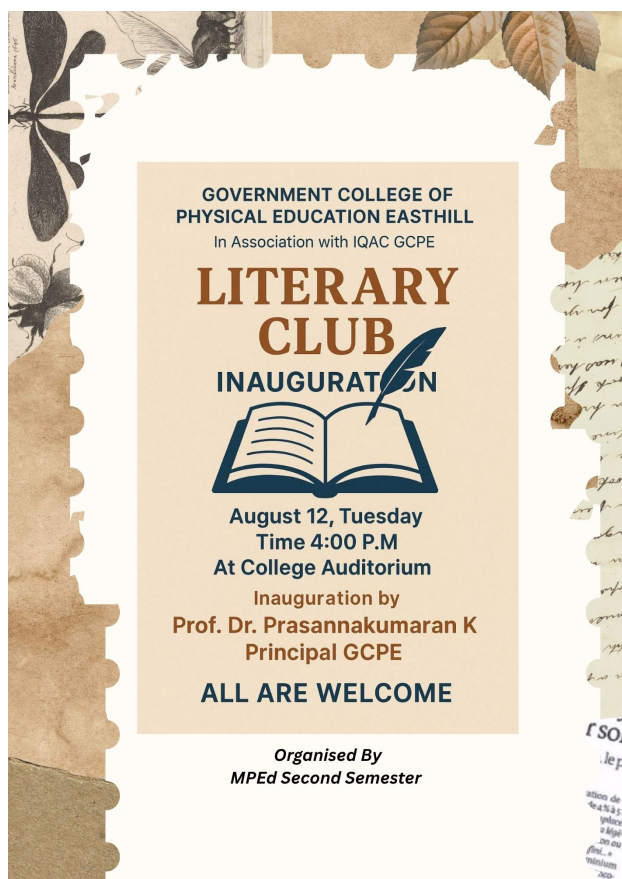
OBJECTIVES OF THE LITERARY CLUB
